BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Stockton in the County of Hunterdon as follows:

SECTION ONE:

The Borough of Stockton, in the County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, (the Borough) is hereby authorized to acquire new or replacement equipment and materials, including installation thereof, for the use of the Stockton Borough Water Utility in, by and for the Borough. Said improvements shall include all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefor.

SECTION TWO:

The sum of \$10,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Water Utility Capital Improvement Fund for the payment of the cost of the improvement authorized and described in Section One hereof.

SECTION THREE:

Said improvements are lawful capital improvements of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements and no part of the cost thereof shall be assessed against the property specially benefited.
