DECEMBER 10, 2018**

A Regular Meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Stockton was called to order by Mayor Timothy Nemeth at 7:03 pm on December 10, 2018. Mayor Nemeth read the “Sunshine Statement” indicating the meeting was being held in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act and led the flag salute.

Mayor's Report – Mayor Nemeth reported that he spoke at the tree lighting ceremony and that it was a nice event.


Mr. Vandegrift reported that the planning board was expected to hear waivers for both the gas station and the Woolverton Inn and that he was disappointed both had to come back again.
