STATE PUBLIC QUESTIONS TO BE VOTED UPON

STATE PUBLIC QUESTION #1
CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO PERMIT WAGERING ON ALL COLLEGE SPORT OR ATHLETIC EVENTS

Do you approve amending the Constitution to permit wagering through casinos and current or former horse racetracks on all college sport or athletic events? YES

Currently, wagering is prohibited on college sport or athletic events that take place in New Jersey. Wagering is also prohibited on an event in which a team from a New Jersey college participates. NO

INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT

Currently, the State Constitution prohibits wagering on college sport or athletic events taking place in New Jersey. It also prohibits wagering on an event in which a New Jersey college team participates. This amendment would allow the Legislature to pass laws permitting wagering on any college sport or athletic event. It would permit wagering even if a New Jersey college team participates in the competition. Such wagering would be permitted only through casinos and current or former horse racetracks.

STATE PUBLIC QUESTION #2
CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT TO ALLOW CERTAIN ORGANIZATIONS AUTHORIZED TO CONDUCT GAMES OF CHANCE TO USE PROCEEDS FROM THOSE GAMES TO SUPPORT THE ORGANIZATION

Do you approve amending the Constitution to permit all groups that are allowed to conduct bingo or raffles to use the net proceeds from those games to support their groups? YES

Currently, only veterans and senior citizen groups may use the net proceeds from those games to support their groups. All other groups that are permitted to conduct bingo or raffles may only use the proceeds from those games for certain purposes. They are not permitted to use those proceeds to support their groups. The amendment would allow the other groups that conduct bingo or raffles to use the proceeds to support their groups as well. NO

INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT

The Constitution permits certain groups to conduct games of chance such as bingo or raffles. Those groups are veterans, charitable, educational, religious, fraternal, civic, and senior citizen groups; volunteer fire companies; and first-aid or rescue squads. The net proceeds from those games of chance may only be used for educational, charitable, patriotic, religious or public-spirited uses. However, veterans and senior citizen groups may also use the proceeds from those games to support their groups. This amendment would permit all of the groups authorized to conduct games of chance to use the net proceeds from conducting bingo or raffles to support their groups.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Project
As set forth in the Proposal below, the Board is seeking to provide the following improvements:

- **New Middle School:** construction and equipping of a new Middle School on the High School site to house grades 5-8; and
- **Lambertville Elementary School:** comprehensive improvements to provide an upgraded district PreK-4 school building including upgraded educational facilities, upgraded building systems including, but not limited to HVAC, electric, and plumbing, improvements to ancillary areas and construction of new, secure main entry.

While the total Project is budgeted at \$33,412,000, after State Funding, the local cost of the Project is approximately \$26,648,007. The Board will issue school bonds to fund the Project costs over a 30 year period.

State Funding for the Project
The Project is eligible for State funding in the form of debt service aid. The State has awarded debt service aid to the district in an amount equal to 40% of "final eligible costs" of the Project, which aid equates to 20.24% of the total costs of the Project. SUCH STATE FUNDING IS ONLY AVAILABLE IF THE PROPOSAL PASSES.






PROPOSAL

The Board of Education of the South Hunterdon Regional School District in the County of Hunterdon, New Jersey is authorized to construct and equip a new Middle School on the High School site to house grades 5-8; and undertake comprehensive Improvements to Lambertville Elementary School to provide an upgraded district PreK-4 school building including upgraded educational facilities, upgraded building systems including, but not limited to HVAC, electric, and plumbing, improvements to ancillary areas and construction of new, secure main entry. The Board is authorized to expend on such project an amount not to exceed \$33,412,000 which expenditure shall be funded with bonds of the School District. The State has agreed to provide debt service aid of 40% of the final eligible costs. The final eligible costs are \$16,909,983. The project includes \$3,076,216 school facilities construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education, or that are not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The local shares of each of the projects may be transferred among projects.

- 4** AFTER YOU HAVE COMPLETED ALL YOUR SELECTIONS, THEN PRESS THE  BUTTON LOCATED IN THE LOWER RIGHT HAND CORNER OF THE MACHINE. THIS ELECTRONICALLY RECORDS ALL YOUR VOTES.
- 5** PART THE CURTAINS AND EXIT THE VOTING BOOTH.

When choosing a **personal choice (write-in)**, whatever **office** you choose to put in a personal choice for, that is the only office to which the vote will be counted. Any improperly cast vote will not be counted. Please read the face of the ballot carefully before taking this option. 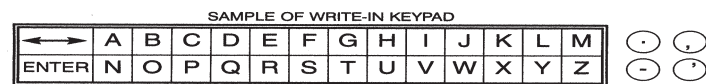
PERSONAL CHOICE (WRITE-IN) INSTRUCTIONS

- 1** UPON ENTERING THE VOTING BOOTH, LOCATE THE OFFICE YOU WISH TO VOTE FOR (OFFICES WILL BE LISTED AT THE TOP OF THE BALLOT) AND FOLLOW THIS COLUMN DOWN TO THE PERSONAL CHOICE COLUMN AND PRESS THE BUTTON.
- 2** A GREEN "←" ARROW WILL BEGIN TO FLASH. (NOTE: THE "←" WILL CONTINUE TO FLASH UNTIL THE WRITE-IN IS COMPLETED).
- 3** AT THE BOTTOM OF THE BALLOT IS THE MAROON WRITE-IN PAD, WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY WAIST HIGH. TYPE IN THE FIRST NAME OF THE CANDIDATE FOR WHOM YOU WISH TO VOTE, USE THE ARROW KEY FOR THE SPACE, AND THEN TYPE IN THE LAST NAME. NOW PRESS "ENTER" WHICH IS LOCATED ON THE PAD.

IF AN ERROR ON THE WRITE-IN IS MADE—BEFORE YOU PRESS ENTER ON THE WRITE-IN KEYPAD—PRESS THE ARROW KEY TO THE LEFT UNTIL THE ERROR IS CLEARED AND THEN RE-TYPE THE NAME. TO MAKE A SPACE—PRESS THE ARROW KEY TO THE RIGHT.

AFTER YOU HAVE COMPLETED VOTING THE ENTIRE BALLOT, PRESS THE ORANGE "CAST VOTE" BUTTON LOCATED ON YOUR LOWER RIGHT-HAND SIDE.

DO NOT PRESS THE CAST VOTE BUTTON UNTIL YOU ARE SURE YOU ARE FINISHED VOTING.
