## BOROUGH OF STOCKTON ADDENDUM/CLARIFICATION #1 TO REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS FOR A CANNABIS BUSINESS LICENSE

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT**, on Thurs., April 9, 2025, Stockton Borough received one question in connection with the above-referenced Request for Applications. The question and the Borough's answer are as follows:

- Q: I was reviewing the cannabis RFA documentation and cannabis ordinance and wanted to see if the borough will accept multiple cannabis retail applications from different operators proposing the same property, assuming each application has the required proof of property control?
- A: The RFA requires each proposal to include sufficient proof that an applicant has the legal right or binding legal commitment to use the proposed location for cannabis retail if granted local approval and a CRC license. Each applicant may only submit one application for one proposed location.

It is possible for more than one applicant to designate the same property for use as a cannabis retail business as long as each applicant provides the required proof of property control as mandated by the RFA. The details and advisability of the foregoing or similar real estate transaction is outside the Borough's purview and strictly a business decision for an applicant to make.

Again, the use of any particular property by an interested cannabis retailer is contingent upon the receipt of the Borough's local support, a CRC license and other approvals required by local ordinance and applicable law, and ultimately, only one licensee may operate at one location in the Borough.
