

Dear Stockton Borough Resident,

Stockton Borough has joined the Hunterdon Area Energy Cooperative (HAEC) energy aggregation program. **ELIGIBLE RESIDENTS* WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY ENTERED INTO THE PROGRAM FOR YOUR PROPERTY'S ELECTRIC UTILITY BILLING.**

As a member of this program, your household will receive bills as usual through JCPL and will receive between a 3% to 4% reduction of your electricity supply costs versus JCP&L's Basic Generation Service prices for the first six (6) months in the new contract term, and an estimated 7% price reduction beginning on June 1, 2026. There will also be a green energy option that you can choose that offers reduced savings.

You will receive an information packet in the mail from <u>Hunterdon Area Energy Cooperative</u> in October, which will explain the program in detail, and it will provide instructions on how to opt out. You will have thirty (30) days in which to choose the standard option or the green energy option or to opt out. If you do not opt out, you will be automatically entered into the standard option of the HAEC energy aggregation program. If you change your mind at any time after the thirty (30) days, you can opt out of or opt in to the energy aggregation program during the contract term without incurring any fees or penalties.

There will be two (2) online information sessions for the HAEC during the thirty (30)-day opt-out period along with a video presentation about the program, which will be made available on the program's web page: https://njaggregation.us/haec

*Eligible residents are those accountholders who 1) have not already enrolled their account for electricity supply with a third-party electricity supplier, 2) don't have a net meter for solar, 3) don't have a time-of-day meter (a.k.a. On-peak/off-peak), and 4) are in good standing with the utility for timely payment. Packets are mailed only to eligible accountholders.
